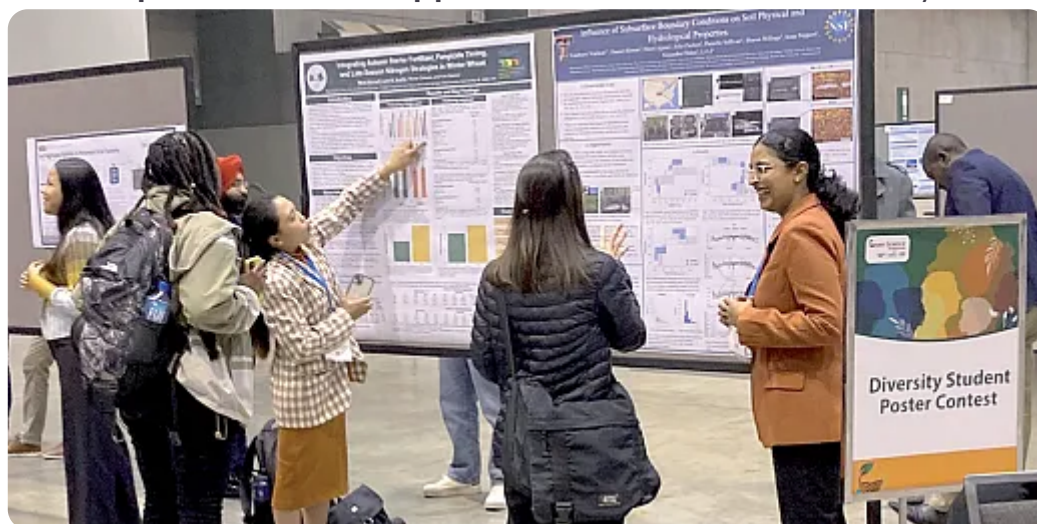


Tiffany Carter (Vice-Chair DEI Committee) presents Huan Hu (China Agricultural University) with a certificate for finishing first in the 2023 contest.

The Diversity Student Poster Contest, conducted by the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) Committee, highlights research conducted by underrepresented graduate and undergraduate students within the Societies. This contest was open to students who self-identify as members of a group that has historically been underrepresented or marginalized within the sciences. More than 400 students initially signed up! The contest is unique as there is a preliminary round that was held virtually at the beginning of October with 100 students submitting their poster. With no travel required for the preliminary round, judges from across countries participated. The final 15 students presented in person at the Annual Meeting.
